#### **Montgomery County District Library Center (DLC)**

### **Five Year Planning Document**

The Montgomery County District Library Center (DLC) supports and aids the district libraries in countywide library development. Despite limited resources, this is accomplished through coordination of services and resource sharing in order to best serve the residents of Montgomery County. For example, the DLC provides access to electronic databases, as well as electronic materials collections through such vendors as Overdrive and RBDigital. The DLC provides regularly scheduled delivery of materials among the public libraries in the county which encourages continued resource sharing among the libraries. Over 1.6 million items were transported in 2018.

The Montgomery County District Library Center provides coordination of professional development opportunities for the district libraries through the efforts of the District Consultant and the Youth Services Consultant. These opportunities have included technology experts; electronic resource demonstrations; trustee workshops; and One Book, One County Author Events. The Montgomery County District Library Center is an advocate for libraries and the informational needs of the Montgomery County community with both funders and elected officials. The DLC acts as a clearinghouse of information on everything from continuing education (CE) opportunities to legislation impacting libraries. This plan lays out a framework for the DLC priorities over the next five years.

Three Subcommittees met over the summer of 2019 to create the 2020-2025 Goals for the three main focal points of the plan: Programming, Collections, and Staff Development. The goals were then submitted to the Five Year Plan Committee Members for review and subsequent recommendation to the District Directors for approval at the December 4, 2019 District Meeting.
